

**NOTICE FOR METRO CLOSURE - BROOKLAND-CUA STATION and Rhode Island Avenue-Brentwood stations on DC Metro's Red Line WILL BE CLOSED DURING THE TIME OF EICUG MEETING (JULY 29-AUGUST 2).**

**OPTIONS TO GET TO CUA:**

1. **By metro:** Free shuttle buses will provide alternate service to CUA from the nearby metro stations, NOMA-Gallaudet and Fort Totten:
  - If you travel from the south, use Red line trains between Gallery Place and NOMA-Gallaudet. Alternatively, you can take the Green or Yellow line trains to Fort Totten (adds up to 15 minutes to your trip)
  - If you travel to/from Red Line stations north of Fort Totten use Green or Yellow line trains between Fort Totten and Gallery Place

The CUA/Brookland shuttle stop is at the bus bay ( <https://www.wmata.com/rider-guide/stations/brookland.cfm> ). You can use the underpass through the metro station to reach the CUA side. 2. **By hotel shuttle:** All recommended hotels provide **shuttle service** to a nearby metro station. See <https://www.jlab.org/conferences/eicugm18/lodging.html> for lodging options.
3. **By uber/lyft:** Can take Uber to campus- for destination on app, type “Caldwell Hall at CUA”. Will bring you to the side facing opposite to Leahy Hall (refer to map of Caldwell hall)
4. **By car:** If coming by car, limited parking space for EICUG is available in the parking garage attached to the CUA Columbus School of Law (3600 John McCormack Dr NE). Can input “Columbus School of Law” on google maps. Refer to CUA Campus Map for exact location of parking garage. It is facing west of Columbus School of Law when coming from Michigan Ave NE → John McCormack Dr NE.

## METrorail

Each passenger needs a SmarTrip® farecard to enter and exit. The card can be reloaded with value and reused to pay Metrorail and Metrobus fares and parking fees at Metro-operated lots.

Buy a SmarTrip® farecard from a FARE VENDING machine at a Metrorail station. Add value to your card at a FARE VENDING or ADD VALUE machine in Metrorail stations, at select retail locations and on our website. Or buy one at over 200 retail locations or online at [wmata.com](http://wmata.com). Online, you can also check your registered card's value, see where and when you used it last or report it lost or stolen.

Fares are based on when and how far you ride. Station-to-station fares are located on station manager kiosks and FARE VENDING machines. The machines accept cash, credit and debit cards. If you use cash, bring small bills; the machines only provide up to \$10 in change.

If you want one day of unlimited Metrorail rides, save money with a One Day Pass. Buy it from a FARE VENDING machine and load it onto your SmarTrip® card.

Up to two children under age five may travel free with a paying customer.

## FARES FOR SENIOR/DISABLED CUSTOMERS

Senior citizens 65 and older and people with disabilities may ride for half the regular fare. On Metrorail, use a Senior or WMATA Reduced Fare Program for People with Disabilities (RFP) Photo/SmarTrip® ID card. On Metrobus, use a Senior or RFP SmarTrip®/ID card.

Customers can also present a valid Medicare card and a photo ID and pay the reduced fare in cash. For details about qualifying for the SmarTrip®/ID card and buying senior SmarTrip® cards, visit [wmata.com](http://wmata.com) or call 202-637-7000 (TTY 202-962-2033).

Free travel training and orientations on how to use accessible Metrobus and Metrorail services are available to senior citizens and people with disabilities by calling 202-962-2703 (TTY 202-962-2033).

## PARKING AT METRO STATIONS

There is a daily fee to park at Metro lots and garages on weekdays. There is no parking fee on weekends and federal holidays. Cash is not accepted, except at metered spaces. All Metro lots and garages accept payment with a SmarTrip® card and most accept major credit cards. Daily parking fees vary by station and are posted at the parking entrance/exit and on our website.

## TRAVEL TIPS

To avoid long lines at FARE VENDING machines after a major event, make sure you have roundtrip fare on your SmarTrip® farecard at the start of your trip.

The weekday rush-hour periods — before 9:30 a.m. and between 3 and 7 p.m. — are the most crowded. If possible, plan your trip to avoid those times.


